

Summit Dance Shoppe Audition Classes for Crystals, Showbiz Kids & Pixies - 2020

Thank you for your interest in our competitive program!

Information about our Crystals competition line:

The "Crystals" are a group of 6-7 year olds. If your dancer is chosen for this line, they will dance 2 times per week (August-June). They will learn a tap dance (1 hour/week) and a jazz dance (1 hour/week), and they will also do 1 hour/week of classical ballet technique. The Crystals will participate in 3 competitions in the spring. The monthly payment last year was \$240. This included tuition, 2 embellished costumes, entry fees for three competitions, and SDS Showcase weekend. The monthly payment for the coming year has not yet been set.

Information about our Showbiz Kids pre-competition line:

The "Showbiz Kids" are a group of 5-6 year olds, who are interested in someday being a part of our competitive program. They will learn and compete a jazz and a tap dance at three local competitions in the spring. The monthly payment last year was \$72, plus \$300 for costumes, and \$300 for competition entry fees.

Information about our Pixies pre-competition line:

The "Pixies" are a group of 4-6 year olds, who are interested in someday being a part of our competitive program. They will learn and compete a jazz dance at three local competitions in the spring. They will also learn a tap dance to perform at recitals. The monthly payment last year was \$56, plus \$170 for costumes and \$165 for competition entry fees.

We have limited space available in these classes due to social distancing guidelines. If we have more registrations than allowed, we will contact you with options. Please register early for the audition classes below.

Fill out the online registration form for Grades Pre-K – 1st Grade (Crystals/Showbiz Kids/Pixies). If you are a returning SDS student with a credit balance on your account, we will deduct your registration from your credits. If you do not have credits or you are a new student to SDS, we will contact you for payment once we receive your online registration. Please know that payment is required before classes start on the 13th.

Additionally, everyone auditioning should register for a recreational class in July, in case they don't make Crystals, SBK or Pixies. If you do make a team, your registration fee & Sept. tuition paid will transfer to your competition line payments.

Classes will meet the weeks of July 13, 20 & 27 at the studio.

COST: \$130 for the session or \$18/class

We will be splitting students into two groups to keep class sizes within COVID-19 guidelines. When you fill out your registration form, please check which class time works best for your dancer. If you are available for both times, please check both boxes. We appreciate you being available for either time.

Please note: All classes are set to take place at the studio, in person. If you would prefer to take class on Zoom at home, please check the "I prefer a Zoom option" box as well as your preferred class time. If enough dancers are interested in taking class on Zoom, we will set one of the class times as a "hybrid" class.

There is no official audition for this age. We will be watching them closely in class and choosing the dancers who we feel would be successful on Crystals, Showbiz Kids or Pixies. We will be sending the results via email by August 1. It is very important that the dancers attend as many classes per week as possible.
